It is the policy of the School District to adhere to the provisions of the Copyright Act of 1976 (P.L. 94-553). Duplication of copyrighted materials without written prior permission from the owner is prohibited except under the fair use doctrine articulated in Section 107 of the Act.

The administration shall develop procedures to implement this policy. Implementation procedures should take into consideration the "Guidelines for Classroom Copying in Not-for-Profit Educational Institutions," the "Guidelines for Off-Air Recording of Broadcast Programming for Educational Purposes" (developed by the Kastenmeier Subcommittee of the U.S. House Judiciary Committee in 1979) and the "Guidelines for Educational Uses of Music" published by the Media and Technology Services Area of the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction in 1979. Procedures for the protection of microcomputer software should take into consideration the guidelines developed by the International Council for Computers in Education (University of Oregon, Eugene, Oregon).
