Regardless of residency at the time of application for enrollment, no student who has been expelled or suspended by any public or independent school (whether or not a member district in the CCSU) shall, during the period of expulsion or suspension, be admitted to the Peacham School, unless otherwise required by law.

If the student is currently a resident of the School District, the school board may use its authority under 16 V.S.A. §1121 (3) to excuse the parent(s) or guardian of the student from responsibility for mandatory attendance until the period of expulsion has expired.
