

**PEACHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT  
PAYMENT OF COURSE TUITIONS FOR  
HOME SCHOOLED STUDENTS PROCEDURE**

Approved: 5/12/03

This is the procedure under which the School Districts of Caledonia Central Supervisory Union will pay tuition charges for courses taken by home-schooled students.

The students and courses meet the following three criteria:

1. The student must be a resident of a member district at the time the course is taken, and obtain a tuition voucher from the School District. The voucher form can be obtained at the district school.
2. The course must be at a grade level not provided by the district school.
3. The school offering the course must qualify for tuition payment under the Vermont Board of Education Manual of Rules and Practices Section 4400, Home Study Students.

Unless otherwise agreed by the School District and the school providing the course, the amount of the tuition shall be computed as follows for a full-semester course:

$$CT = T/2 * C/D$$

T = The full annual tuition allowed under VSA Title 16.

D = The instructional time of a school day

C = The instructional time of the course

CT = The amount to be paid for the course

Clarification: 1/2 a year's tuition prorated to the course time compared to an instructional day's time. Course tuitions will be computed, billed, and paid on a semester basis.
