Note: The sources of these numbers differ for different categories. The source for Peacham Elementary School is the Department of Education's 2003--2007 enrollment tables, reflecting the number of students as of October 1. The source for public and independent schools grades 7 through 12 is CCSU tuition payments; because some students switch schools and homeschoolers attend only a limited number of classes, these figures are not a headcount, but rather a "full time equivalent." The source for students in independent schools as of October 1, for which no tuition payments are made (elementary and religious schools), and for homeschoolers, is the Department of Education, with a few corrections from Stevens School records for elementary school grades.
