Collaboration- could use Danville for specials not available here for possible Peacham 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students if the elementary school added a middle school. Advantage that students could participate in sports. Some Peacham students do play on Danville teams.

Fred envisions a Joint Agreement to take elementary students only. Possibly keeping preschool and kindergarten here in Peacham and bring Danville students here for those grades. Extra space could be used by CCSU (possible income). How would specials be affected for this age group. Does this age group participate in specials now/

Would significantly lower Danville costs and would offer us lower cost per student and keep them together and close to the Peacham community. It would also be closer for some families to send children to Danville. There is currently bus service that takes middle and high school students to Danville.

Bus service might be better provided by Peacham school board. Busing cost for high school and middle school students going to Danville is already included in the tuition we pay to Danville. Costs might increase for us.

Special ed costs- who pays. Do we only pay if the student's needs go beyond the specialists in the school, i.e. one on one aid.

Rob is interested in seeing a model of costs if we had entered into this type of agreement 5 years ago and what it would have cost us last year if we had done this. How would the costs affect Peacham, Danville? Rob Billings will need to provide the numbers. Jo Anne will call and bring the issues to Rob (Billings).
